Actually that is the MooTools Slide effect doing that. You want to turn of mootools effects (not mootools script load) and that will go away, or leave on the effect and change the slide to horizontal.

Then if you still have trouble you may open the CSS and add a fixed height. If you need help with that part let us know.

2) I change with settings that your suggest
#moolet_total_users_frame

not div.moolet_total_users_loading (that seems doesn't work with your settings)

...now I get what I want but only with Slide to Horizontal.

...slide to Vertical doesn't work fine.

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
