Thank you for your answer! My site is importing only the mootools.1.1.js file now and I can see the avatars (hurray!) but only in IE (not in the Mozilla and Safari).

I think I need some kind of CSS correction since I can see in that avatars are imported in the Firebug but hidden behind other div-s. Can you recommend some kind of CSS correction for my vertical left module?

I've noticed also that the same module on the moolets site has a nice div that contains a list of links and images, compared with my module where I've nested span-s containing links and images (class vertical frame).
