Yes, the sunblogger template you are using has a customized copy of mootools that does not support bounce. You can try to disable that in the module or simply turn back on using the mootools file I provided and leave your sunblogger copy on also.

Firebug showed me this error so I think I am correct.

Fx.Transitions.Bounce has no properties

Sorry you are having a bit of trouble with this. It is a rather complicated chunk of code...

Mootools.js files are generally version 1.0 which is out of date. The Moolets require mootools version 1.1 and the file names are generally mootools.v1.11.js as so you can still keep your old file in the same directory.

There should be a parameter to include this file into the module but if that does not work hard code it to:

```
/modules/mod_moolet_online/js/mootools.v1.11.js
```

Mike,
I got lost along the way on this thread myself.

These modules are simply not going to work on all servers. I run linux / apache but have a dedicated server where I have total control. Shared hosts or windows hosts may not always cut it for Mootools + Ajax.

In your modules folder there should be the uploaded module file:
mod_moolet_online.php

on line 83 is the mootools-ajax javascript file insert.

echo '<script src="/modules/mod_moolet_online/js/mootools.v1.11.js" type="text/javascript"></script>' . "\n";
```

Might take the the line out of the PHP and put it in the head of your template.

Unfortunately I couldn't get it work. I am sure my domain is hosted on a linux server, and my script settings are correct. The thing is, I tried to remove other mootools.js file and use your mootools, but it didn't work.

I think the problem is elsewhere. Probably because of the users. I had a SMF - Joomla bridge installed, which I removed some days ago, but I think there are some problems with the users there. I've got 1400 members, and maybe it couldn't get the user data from there, although I've synchronized the list with Community Bulider.

Although it's a great module, I cannot use it.

I tried other templates too.

If you want to try, you can login to the site with user/pass: moolet/moolet

Hello,
The first issue I see is you are including 2 mootools.js files, the one that came with sunblogger template and the one that came with my module. You only want one mootools file to load even if you have 20 modules.

So here is a problem for you, the mootools.js with sunblogger is a partial subset, so if you use that one my module will not work.

The sunblogger tab on the template is old outdated code for mootools 1.0 and will not work with the mootools 1.1 file included. There may be and update at yootheme for some new tab code?

Here is where to configure mootools.js files, but mine has all the functions

I keep my file at

/scripts/js/mootools.v1.11.js to conform with joomla 1.5 standards as mootools is native to 1.5 and that is where the file is kept.

Then I changed my path in sunblogger to bring in this file. Then I turn off include mootools file in ALL my modules.

I will need you to get that far before I can see what else is needed to bring in the Avatars. I suspect we may need to change the language file. I think we hard coded this path for you in the total users module. might have to do the same think here

Hello Brian,

I've tried every possibilities, and I think your module is working correctly. It gets the data from the original joomla installation.

The only problem is the images. For example, if I type turkmac for sub folder, the module stops working, because the module is trying to get data from the sub-sub-turkmac folder, which doesn't exist.:
