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I need the moolet in place to hit the page with "Firebug" to trace the DOM elements, without that trace I am waisting my

time.

I can tell you this about your page right now. The moolet should NOT work at all.

- 1) check previous posts here. you need to get rid of the mootools 1.0 script you have in your site as it is outdate and wipes out the mootools 1.1 functions needed for moolets
- 2) You can only have one mootools script period. If you have multi modules that use mootools like you do, Put a fully packed 1.1 script in the head of your template and turn off all the load scripts in the modules. I supplied a packed 1.1.
- 3) If you hit your site with Firebug now you have four major javascript errors that need fixed before you reload the moolet.

They are:

- 1) this.\$events.keys has no properties
- 2) Fx has no properties
- 3) this.\$events.keys has no properties (again)
- 4) this.\$events.keys has no properties (again)

hope all that helps

Might take the time to load Firebug into Firefox for debugging your site, even if you do not use it as your regular browser.

All this needs fixed before I could fix the moolet.

For the other errors, in the site which show clearly using i.e. 7.0 but not on Firefox I might use some of your expert help ;) ;)

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Hello,  
What I am saying is I can not run a trace with two mootools files in place, even if it is working.  
I did notice in the source code the moolet is set to vertical and put in a horizontal space, this can be seen by the "v"s in the divs

moolet\_online\_fb\_v\_frame

instead of an h

moolet\_online\_fb\_h\_frame

You might just need to set it up on the sidebar

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
