1)mootools-release-1.11.js is the right version but do you know if it is fully packed? if not switch it out with the version I supplied that has all the functions. not just the ones needed to drive the template

2) This file can execute. Maybe your host is not allowing the language file include. You would need to get your host to change that setting in their php.ini settings or find a new host, nothing i can do about that
