Hello,
I did not see the map but I saw some serious issues with your home page. If you view source you will see you are loading three mootools.v1.11.js scripts in various forms. You can only load one per site. While your modules are creating mootools functions another script comes along and whipes them out. I would leave the top one in the template, then replace it with one you know is fully packed. Most site templates do not have packed the functions the template needs. A fully packed mootools.js file will cover all modules by all developers in one file. More on packing see mootools.net. The file I provided is fully packed. The last mootools file in your series is not compressed and adding a bit of bog to your bandwidth, def get rid of that thing.

Also after you get that fixed hit your site with Firebug and check out the error that pesky clock is throwing. You will need to fix that clock or remove it from the page you want the map on.
