I installed the latest release of total users today and am getting the following message.

The module starts to load then locks up the page loading at the module position. The above error is then displayed just below the module.

I have tried the post & get variations but no difference. I have Joomla 1.0.13 and the latest release of CB.

Okay, I do see two issues.

- 1) You are using frames. They are very evil and its going to be hit or miss on the tools working with that.
- 2) You are loading multiple copies of mootools which is not permitted as one file wipes out functions set up in anther.

If you view source you will see this

/templates/yt_page/lib/js/mootools.js.php

modules/mod_moolet_online_fb/mootools.v1.11.js

modules/mod_moolet_total_users/mootools.v1.11.js

Probably on the last one in this chain will work which is the total users

I would change the first one in your template to read a 1.11 file and turn off the other two

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
